Our most significant impact is resource consumption especially electricity, which for the most part is generated from non-renewable resources and causes the release of greenhouse gasses during its production. We try to reduce our footprint on the environment by altering business practices such as using environmentally friendly paper, recycling where possible, and operating a managed delivery service.

Gemini Digital Colour Ltd understands that its operations have an impact on the local and global environment and is committed to the continual environmental improvement of its activities.

Gemini Digital Colour will:

- Be committed to compliance with all environmental legislation that applies to the Company. We will keep up to date with changes in legislation through close contact with BPIF, IPIA and our local county council.
- Aim to prevent pollution aided through a process of continual environmental improvement.
- Increase the proportion of waste recycled.
- Work towards targets set out in the Company's environmental improvement plan, which was developed from an environmental review of the Company.
- Ensure all the Company's staff are aware of this Policy and the environmental management system.
- Ensure all staff are trained in environmental issues related to their roles.

Gemini Digital Colour Ltd. Statement of Environmental Impacts

Gemini Digital Colour Ltd is the UK's longest established Digital Colour printer. Since 1995, running three Indigo sheet fed presses, we have pioneered the use of digital colour printing and personalisation in this country. Gemini Digital Colour is also an established fine art printer, producing limited edition giclée prints for some of the countries leading artists.

Gemini Digital Colour Ltd understands that its operations have an impact on the local and global environment and is committed to the continual environmental improvement of its activities.

The main raw materials used by the organisation are various types of paper, electroink, electronics, imaging oil, imaging agent, cardboard boxes, ink, printer cartridges, laminating film and shrink wrap. We realise that these materials are a use of natural resources and that some of them have the potential to cause harm to the environment if spilled. We will ensure that storage is such that any spillage is contained and the risk to the environment minimised.

The most significant impact involved in the production of our product is the use of electricity, which for the most part is generated from non-renewable resources and causes the release of greenhouse gasses during its generation production. Some water is also used on site, mainly for domestic purposes, which is a precious natural resource.

We try to use our raw materials as efficiently as possible to avoid waste. However, we do produce quantities of waste, including some hazardous waste (oily water). At present electronic, paper and cardboard from the site is recycled, but all other waste is disposed of to landfill, via appropriately licensed companies. We understand that this is a source of land, water and air pollution and are investigating if any other fractions of our waste can be segregated and recycled.
